A shareable resource developed by Dr Jane Pilcher of Nottingham Trent University, drawing on findings from the Say My Name research project funded by the British Academy.

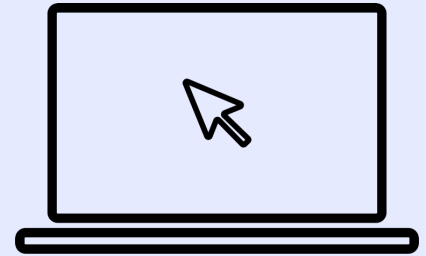

8 STEPS TO MAKE AN AUDIO NAMEBADGE

Go to name-coach.com

**STEP
01**

Click on Our Services, then Personal NameBadge, then Get Your NameBadge.



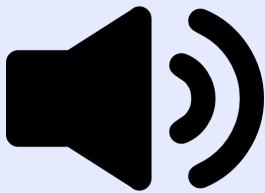
Add your details

Complete the relevant fields on the form. You can include even phonetic spelling & pronouns if you want!

**STEP
02**

Record your name

The easiest way to record your name is to use the Web Recorder option. When you are happy with your recording, select submit.



**STEP
03**

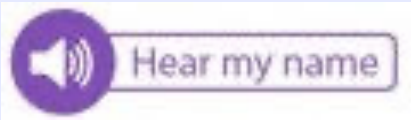
Add NameBadge

Skip setting a password (unless you want to) & then, go to the next page, select Add NameBadge to Your Email Signature.

**STEP
04**

Customise your NameBadge

Choose from the options to copy a button or a link.



**STEP
05**

Access email signature

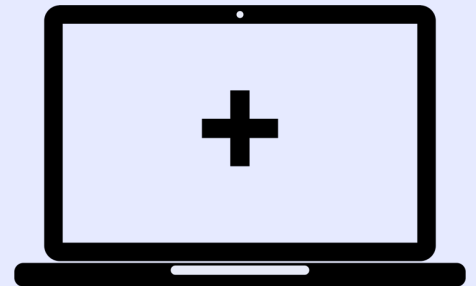
Access your email signature. E.g., on the Outlook web app, click Settings > View all Outlook settings > Compose and reply.

**STEP
06**

Add your NameBadge

Use Ctrl+V to paste your chosen button or link into your signature. You can move your button using drag & drop & you can resize the font.

07**



Save and Finish

Select save. Start composing a new message. Your email signature now includes your NameBadge!
