## 8 STEPS TO MAKE AN AUDIO NAMEBADGE

#### Go to name-coach.com


### STEP 01

Click on Our Services, then Personal NameBadge, then Get Your NameBadge.

#### **Add your details**

Complete the relevant fields on the form. You can include even phonetic spelling & pronouns if you want!

#### **Record your name**

The easiest way to record your name is to use the Web Recorder option. When you are happy with your recording, select submit.


#### **Add NameBadge**

Skip setting a password (unless you want to) & then, go to the next page, select Add NameBadge to Your Email Signature.

STEP 04

#### **Customise your NameBadge**

Choose from the options to copy a button or a link.



STEP 05

#### **Access email signature**


Access your email signature. E.g., on the Outlook web app, click Settings > View all Outlook settings > Compose and reply.

## STEP 06

#### **Add your NameBadge**

Use Ctrl+V to paste your chosen button or link into your signature. You can move your button using drag & drop & you can resize the font.

STEP 07



#### **Save and Finish**

STEP 08 Select save. Start composing a new message. Your email signature now includes your NameBadge!
